- Describe the work environment.
- Is it the company's policy to promote from within?
- What is the overall structure of the department where the position is located?
- What characteristics does a successful person have at your company?
- Please describe a typical day on the job.
- How are employees evaluated and promoted?
- What are the typical career paths? What are realistic time frames?
- How has working at this company influenced your personal and professional growth?

#### Questions you may be asked....

- Tell me about yourself.
- What are your short-term and long-term career goals?
- What are the most important rewards you expect in your career?
- What do you consider to be your greatest strengths and weaknesses?
- How has your college experience prepared you for a career?
- Why should I hire you? Why do you want this position?
- What qualifications do you have that make you think you will be successful?
- In what ways do you think you can make a contribution to our organization?

- What two or three accomplishments have given you the most satisfaction?
- Why did you choose the career for which you are preparing?
- In what kind of work environment are you most comfortable?
- How would you describe the ideal job for your following graduation?
- What do you know about our organization?
- Do you have a geographical preference? Will your relocate?
- Describe a major problem you have encountered and how you dealt with it.
- What motivates you to put forth your greatest effort?
- Do you have plans for continued study? An advanced degree?
- Do you think your grades are a good indication of your academic achievements?
- What non-career related goals have you established for yourself in the next 5 years?
